STUDENT RIGHTS

1. Participation by students with disabilities in the DSPS program is entirely voluntary, however, services and accommodations provided by IVC are managed and maintained in the DSPS office (56008, a).
2. Receiving DSPS support services or specialized instruction does not preclude a student from also participating in any other course program or activity offered by the college (56008, b).
3. All records maintained by DSPS personnel pertaining to students with disabilities are protected from disclosure and are subject to all other requirements for handling of student records (56008, c).
4. DSPS Student Responsibilities are provided to students with this form at the time of application into DSPS.
5. It is your responsibility to update this office on any change of address or phone number.
6. Written notice will be provided to any student eligible for suspension or termination of services or accommodations.
7. An appeal process has been established through the DSPS office in the event a student disagrees with a DSPS decision or that of an instructor in relation to services or accommodations. Contact the Counselor in the DSPS office for a copy of or information about the Grievance Policy and Procedures.
