

TAG (Transfer Admission Guarantee)

What a great way to go!

Are you ready to transfer? If you are applying for Fall 2010 to one of the many UC's that offer guaranteed admission, then you may qualify to participate in a TAG. Here are some of the schools that require EARLY action on your part, prior to the November application filing period.

Both the process and the deadlines to apply vary from school to school. The Transfer Center offers TAG workshops to assist students plan effectively.

Wednesday, October 23, 2009 – TAG Drop-In 1:00-2:00 p.m. in the SC Quad

Monday, September 28, 2009 – TAG Workshop- 12:30-1:30 p.m. in the Transfer Center, SC 230, 949-451-5339.

UC Davis – offers guaranteed admission to eligible students with a 2.8-3.10 transferable GPA and must be a full-time student. Students must complete a contract by making an appointment in the Transfer Center from September 1, no later than Sept. 23, 2009 and have it postmarked by September 30, 2009. UC Irvine – offers guaranteed admission to well-qualified students with a 3.0 transferable GPA; and who have completed **Writing 1 (by summer 2009)**; a transferable **Math course (by summer 2009)**, and who will complete Writing 2 by spring 2010. Former UC students who left in good standing ARE eligible, while students who have coursework from other (non-UC) four-year college/universities are NOT eligible. **Students who have any foreign/international coursework are NOT eligible. Students who already have a degree from a four-year university are NOT eligible.**

Eligible and interested students MUST complete an online “TAG Checklist” between September 1 through October 15, 2009. Information is available at www.admissions.uci.edu/tag.

UC Santa Cruz – offers guaranteed admission to students who have completed a minimum of 30-UC transfer semester units by summer 2009; have fewer than 20 semester units completed at a four-year institution, and have at least a 3.0 GPA.
