

## Transfer Updates - what you need to know....

### CSU Long Beach Update:

CSULB is facing severe pressure due to the budget shortfalls during this difficult fiscal situation. Due to the tremendous demand for admission by freshman and transfer students, CSULB will not be able to accommodate all qualified students at their campus.

Anticipating even great enrollment demand in 2009-2010 because CSULB is:

- A low cost, high quality institution
- Experiencing increased student continuation rates and unit loads
- Within driving distance for many students
- Reducing enrollment for freshmen and transfer y 2,200 students.

### For Fall 2009-2010 admission, CSULB will be:

- Impacted for freshmen, using significantly higher criteria for applicants from non-local high schools
- Impacted for upper-division transfers, using significantly higher criteria for applicants from community colleges in all non-impacted majors except for transfers from Long Beach City College.
- Impacted for majors at the transfer level, with even higher criteria for admission to majors including: Nursing, Business, Options in Kinesiology, Social Work, Psychology, Criminal Justice, Film and Electronics, Radiation Therapy, Fine Arts and the Studio Art option.
- CSULB's preferred term of entrance for undergraduates is Fall. In the unlikely event that resources improve, CSULB MAY offer access for spring transfers. IF SO, CSULB WILL ATTEMPT TO CONTACT COMMUNITY COLLEGES AS EARLY AS SUMMER 2009.
- Admission communication and important deadlines : Please be aware that due to competitive admissions, admission decisions are being made in "rounds" and CSULB will also implement a wait list.
- June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009 is the deadline to submit your Intent to Enroll along with a \$150.00 non-refundable deposit.

### San Jose State University Update: Fall 2009 Lower Division Transfers

- SJSU will no longer accept applications from lower division transfers, regardless of major.
- Transfers must be fully eligible as upper division transfers to be considered for admission.
- Prospective lower division transfers are urged to contact CSU East Bay, as space is available at their sister campus.
- SJSU has determined that most waitlisted transfer applicants for Fall 2009 will not be accommodated. All transfers who applied on or after Nov. 20 and earned the majority of their units at a college located outside of Santa Clara County were placed on a waitlist.

### NEW PROGRAM FOR UCI HONORS- THE (Transfer Honors Enrollment) GUARANTEE

This new program is a guaranteed admission to UCI with a GPA of 3.5 or higher in all programs except Business, Nursing, Engineering, and Performing Arts which requires a supplemental application. Students must participate in IVC Honors Program and complete 5 courses (totaling 15 units), with a grade point average of 3.5 or higher to qualify. Students will receive:

- Priority registration for classes at UCI
- Guaranteed Housing while at UCI
- Special Advising
- College Honors Program (CHP) lounge access
- Special social events for CHP students
- Senior thesis opportunity
- Potential for Regent's Scholarships for admitted students.

**CSUF: Fall 2009 transfer students**, please note that if you were enrolled in a Golden Four Course (Writing 1, Critical Thinking, Speech 1, or Math) this spring 2009, CSUF has requested that you send them your grades by June 15<sup>th</sup> or your application will be withdrawn. Make sure you respond to this request in a timely manner!

**UC Davis Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) for Fall 2010**  
**Your Ticket to UC Davis**

If you are interested in transferring to Davis next fall and wish to participate in the TAG program, you need to:

- Make an appointment in the Transfer Center beginning **September 1, 2009 and no later than September 23, 2009**. Call (949) 451-5339 or stop by SC 230 to make an appointment.
- To qualify for the TAG you must meet the following criteria: (1) Completed 30 UC-transferable units; (2) Have a minimum 2.8 GPA or higher (2.8-3.10 depending on major); (3) Be a full-time IVC student; (4) Complete 60 transferable units by Spring 2010.
- Students will receive online TAG Decision in November.

- The TAG will guarantee your admission to Davis, to the major that you want, for a specified term, as long as you meet the stipulations of the agreement and apply for admission during the open filing period.
