**MINUTES**

Meeting minutes from November 18, 2005 were reviewed and approved by those in attendance. No changes were voted on.

**REPORTS**

**Presidents Report:**

- Snack Bar opportunity was discussed for the weekend of December 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> for the dance recital. Also additional opportunities were discussed by Colin, for the upcoming Women's basketball tournament, December 8<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup>.
- Reminder from Chris that for those that are planning on attending Nationals, they need to do a **minimum** of 6 hours at the snack bar, 3 hours of door security, and 2 additional hours of community service.
- XTE holiday party will be held on December 16, 2005. Chris will be e mailing out directions to the location of the party. A motion was made by Albert Garcia to spend \$350.00 dollars for the party (\$100.00 of this is for the cost to rent the place the party will be at); the motion was seconded by Darrell Short, and was approved by a majority vote.
- Chris Brown will be arranging for a field trip to the Orange County Sheriff's Department Crime Lab, possible dates that were discussed were the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> week of January after the new semester has started.
- Tonight's meeting is the last Business meeting of the semester and of 2005, however there will still be another meeting on December 16, 2005. Also any unfinished business will be carried over to the next official Business meeting.
- Next official Business meeting will meet on January 6, 2006.

**Vice-Presidents Report:**

- No report, Vice-President was not in attendance tonight.

**Treasurers Report:**

- Colin McCaughey handed out copies of XTE's financial status for all members in attendance to view.

### **Committee Reports:**

- Fundraising report given by Ana Lindemann advised that we still need XTE members to donate items to sell at the snack bar.
- Social Committee is now being headed up by Ariel (Ace) Gatus. Ace will also be responsible for arranging our gig for the talent show for Nationals.

### **Misc. Reports:**

- Colin is now taking T-shirt orders. Also if you have suggestions for possible new colors both for the shirt and logo, e-mail Colin. He will be placing the order for the shirts in January. The cost of the shirts is \$10.00 dollars for regular T-shirts and \$20.00 dollars for Polo shirts. Cash is an acceptable method of paying, however if you are paying by check, the check needs to be made payable to: Stitch em' up custom embroidery
- All those interested in going to Nationals, and having it paid for by IVC, Colin needs to have a firm commitment from you **NO LATER THAN** January 6, 2006. If you commit, and after January 6, you change your mind, you will be responsible for all charges that have been incurred by XTE as a result of your commitment. Also if you don't commit by the deadline, but find out afterwards that you can make it, you will be responsible for your own expenses. Also in order to be eligible for ASIVC funds the following criteria must be met: 1) have at least a 2.0 GPA, 2) be enrolled in a minimum of 6 units at IVC (you can not have 3 units at IVC and 3 at Saddleback), with at least 3 of these units AOJ units, 3) Your ASIVC dues need to be paid. These dues cost \$5.00 dollars and can be paid for at the Bursars office in the student services building.
