
- Student population exceeds 12,680





#### **DSPS Appointments**

Once Matriculation is complete schedule an appointment with a DSPS counselor

- 1. Intake (1.5 hours)
  - Provide verification of disability
  - Complete interactive process
  - Authorize IVC accommodations
- 2. Academic Counseling (30min-1hr)
  - Review and plan first semester classes
- 3. Follow up (Fall Semester)
  - Review accommodations, policies and procedures

Students are recommended to meet with a DSPS counselor ONCE a semester.
