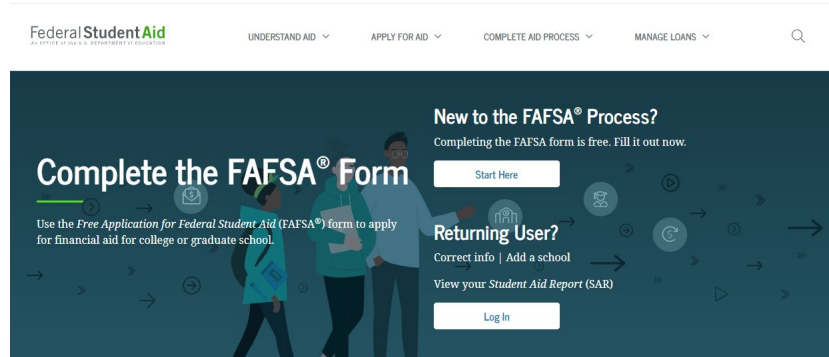

# CCPG Fee Waiver vs. Irvine Valley Promise

## CCPG

Formerly BOG Waiver

Awarded to all low-income students

No unit requirement

## Irvine Valley Promise

Awarded to low- and high-income students

Waives the health fee and ASIVC fee

Enroll full-time\* (12 units+)

\*Unless exempted

Student must complete FAFSA/ CADAA

Waives enrollment fees (\$46 per unit)

# DSPS Appointments

Once Matriculation is complete schedule an appointment with a DSPS counselor

1. Intake (1.5 hours)

- ❖ Provide verification of disability
- ❖ Complete interactive process
- ❖ Authorize IVC accommodations

2. Academic Counseling (30min- 1hr)

- ❖ Review and plan first semester classes

3. Follow up (Fall Semester)

- ❖ Review accommodations, policies and procedures

**Students are recommended to meet with a DSPS counselor ONCE a semester.**
