



**ESTIMATE OF EXPENSES 2023-2024**

**(Fees subject to change in fall 2024)**

The following estimates are for one academic year (2 semesters). International students are required to enroll and successfully complete a minimum of 12 units per semester. All figures are in US dollars.

International Student Tuition: <i>(\$456/unit)</i>	\$10,944
Health Center Fee:	\$52
Medical Health Insurance <i>(required):</i>	\$2,200
Books, supplies and incidentals:	\$1,680
Housing:*	\$14,000
<b>TOTAL:</b>	<b>\$28,876</b>

**DEPENDENTS (*spouse or children*):** An additional \$5,000 per dependent is required to cover living expenses for dependent(s). Bank information showing this additional amount must be submitted in order for an I-20 to be issued.

The District mandated health insurance plan must be purchased by all international students prior to registration. Fees are estimates and are subject to change.

\* Housing costs may increase depending on option chosen. Students can live with local host families or in off-campus apartments. Visit [Housing](#) for local housing options.

The above fees represent the minimum estimated tuition and living expenses that an international student can expect to pay while attending Irvine Valley College. Applicants must show funding of US \$28,876 in order to receive the I-20; the I-20 is the document needed to apply for the F-1 visa. Fees are subject to change by the State of California and the South Orange County Community College District Board of Trustees. Tuition and fees are due in full at the time of registration.
