NEW BUSINESS

Item 14 IVC Student Success and Support Program (SSSP) Plan

Discussion: IVC's <u>SSSP Plan Draft (version 5)</u> is presented to Academic Senate for Rep Council's review. Arleen Elseroad is available to answer faculty questions. Elseroad: Draft has included faculty involvement of Brenda Borron, Miriam Castroconde, Jeff Wilson, Rebecca Beck, and Robert Melendez. SSSP reinstates old matriculation dollars but they can only spend on orientation, assessment, and advisement. In response, IVC launched Freshman Advantage. The Counseling department indicated there has been an impact because students are now required to have a comprehensive education plan once they reach 15 units or in their 3rd semester. Also, students surveyed preferred in-person orientation over the online orientation option. As a result, Counseling and A&R recommend hiring four counselors and two senior matriculation specialists. Additionally they recommend hiring two evaluators to review transcripts, as well as an additional administrative assistant to provide support. Send comments and suggestions to <u>ASENATE@ivc.edu</u>.
