F. EXECUTIVE REPORTS

Senate President: Kathy Schmeidler: The District-wide Strategic Planning council meeting on Feb. 5 should be discussing more integrated concepts on how resources are allocated across the district.

Craig Hayward: The IVC mission statement is being reviewed. We are looking at the district-wide mission statement, which integrates changes by accreditation standard, while trying to develop a purpose statement that is more concise, more memorable, and still gets to the heart of the matter. We will participate in a national survey that will be a key performance indicator used to measure student engagement.

Vice-President: Bob Urell: Enrollment at IVC is up for the Spring Semester but still flat for the year. We need to continue working on enrollment. There is a link to the <u>budget report</u> presented by Vice President Davit during FLEX week. BRPC is looking at the possible reasons for the trend resulting in flat enrollments in the International

students program. Enrollment management is still meeting to discuss ways to increase enrollment and visibility for our college. The CEC classrooms were completely renovated in time for Spring classes; thank Jeff Hurlbut, Director, IVC Facilities, for getting them ready.

Academic Affairs Chair: Brett McKim – The first of the DAL series will be Michelle Evans, X15 historian. On April 12, Nathan DeWall will present on self-control, self-regulation, and brain training. On May 19, we will have Norman Stolzoff, a cultural anthropologist.

Curriculum Committee Chair: Diana Hurlbut – Courses that undergo minor revision can now be sent to the State Chancellors office without further review; however, as a result of this quick approval the degree or certificate will be out of date. Changes to a degree or certificate must be sent to the curriculum committee at the same time that a faculty submits their minor course revisions. Dean Fahimi pointed out that since IVC is working on interactive e-catalog, it has highlighted many problems with outdated degrees and certificates.

Item 14 Emergency Response

Discussion: An invited speaker presented on campus safety organization during FLEX week., The faculty and some staff were a calming influence during the "free speech event" on Wednesday; see Public Comments discussion. The IVC police are hoping to set up a "cadet" program, which will provide campus escorts. The proposed door-securing widgets were not ADA compliant, so other devices, as well as electronic door locks and/or a camera system are being investigated. On-going problems include: Chemicals on-campus and proper safety training. There was a recent break-in to BSTIC, windows were broken and computers stolen. Action Taken: None.

Item 15 CLA+ Assessment Tool

Discussion: The assessment tool is from 3rd party. There would be a \$35 fee per assessment with a minimum cost of \$3500. The CLA+ will be used only for students that will graduate with degree, not those only earning certificates or taking classes. A \$3500 pilot is proposed. Participating students will get results for colleges or job placement. The data will be used for institutional learning outcomes. It is not customizable, but lines up with 6 out of 11 of our outcomes. Please bring back to schools for further discussion.
