- C. Cross-Disciplinary Community of Practice
  - A group of faculty from different disciplines/fields discussing what is/is not working
  - Share with schools/departments to see what they think
- D. Cheryl Bailey California Virtual College and Online Exchange Initiative (CVC-OEI)
  - Link to website: cvc.edu
  - CVC is providing a database of all the submitted online courses from various colleges
  - Schools have full control over what shows up in the database; CVC is not pulling the info from the colleges, rather colleges are voluntarily offering up info on courses they want in the database
  - Database will contain info regarding whether online class offered at a different institution will transfer to IVC and, if yes, what class it yields credit for
  - Current worry is students will take easier versions of courses elsewhere and still get an IVC degree
  - Counselors suggested to CVC that very large disclaimers be made when choosing these courses that it's possible they don't transfer and to talk to a counselor prior to registering for the course, has not been done yet
  - Major benefit of CVC-OEI is for students in rural areas that lack access to nearby institutions, which is not our typical student demographic
  - In the next year (i.e. by Fall 2021) we need to vote on whether or not we want to become a "teaching college", which entails:
    - Every semester, submitting specific sections of specific classes that are 100% online to  $\mathrm{CVC}$
    - Taking in students from other schools/areas (we'd get the money for them) without having to register at IVC
    - Striving to get 20% of classes offered through CVC to be peer-reviewed based off of OEI rubric (very aspirational because no consequences for not meeting this and no school is currently close to that mark); benefit of this is these peer-reviewed courses show up higher in search results/rankings
  - One benefit to being a teaching college if an IVC student goes to CVC, IVC classes will always show up at the top of the list
  - Still a lot of information in flux, we have a year to decide, just want to start the conversation early

## E. Online Education Coordinator Position

- Current approach to online education seems piecemeal and does not seem to be adapting fast enough to keep up with current demand
- A dedicated position for online education could help make this transition easier and more effective, and would be better suited to keep track of all the other issues that could be affecting online education (for example, CVC-OEI)
- We have Tim for the technical issues of online courses, we need somebody that can take charge and put their focus on implementing good online pedagogy, especially if we're going to have more online courses post-COVID
- We could also create a Faculty Center where faculty can go to create their online materials (videos, light boards, etc.), and an online education coordinator could take charge of setting this up
- Currently there's a resource request in for an instructional designer
