#### 12. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Zoom-bombing/Incident Response Playbook: Jeff Dorsz
  - District Online Education Committee (DOEC) developed the playbook because responses to previous Zoom-bombing incidents were a bit disjointed
  - If an incident occurs, the faculty member should still contact their dean
  - District is creating an advisory dean role (for about 12 months) that will be the main point of contact for these types of issues; advisory dean will be pulled in to help the dean if the issue is substantial enough
  - Faculty concerns -
    - Change wording so the preventive settings are recommended, not mandated (some faculty feel the restrictions to guarantee no Zoom-bombing trade off with the ability to interact with the students)
    - Make it clear faculty are not held responsible if an incident occurs whether or not they followed the guidelines

# B. SSAMMO Revisions

- Student Success, Access, Matriculation, Marketing, and Outreach committee (SSAMMO) is undergoing substantial changes in name, purpose, charge, and membership
- Link to proposed changes [name changed to Student Success and Equity (SSE)]
- State Academic Senate has asked all local Senates to prepare a DEI survey (gap analysis), and it would be easier to executive if all the equity initiatives were already mapped

## C. SPAC Revisions

- Name changed to College Council
- FA would like a seat on College Council, two reasons:
  - legally have a right because the committee discusses workplace issues that are FA issues
  - when planning for the future of IVC having an FA member on College Council can identify FA-related issues ahead of time in order to prevent them from occurring
- Another option would be Senate maintaining control of who is on the committee and making it best practices to appoint somebody from FA
  - gets the benefits outlined above
  - allows Senate to guarantee the FA representative chosen is from IVC

- D. Return to Campus Protocols for Fall 2021 (Protocols, Disinfection Plan, and Pandemic Prep and Response Plan): Dr. Chris McDonald
  - Multiple lengthy documents have been sent out regarding this issue, which can be difficult to sort through, so a short set of PowerPoint slides highlighting the most pertinent information is in the works
  - If you're interested in having classes on campus, let Dr. McDonald know and he will schedule a meeting with the dean and the chair and do campus tours to outline processes necessary (these processes will be customized because needs/requirements vary by department)
  - The number of times on campus can be discussed as well, can still do hybrid instruction

# F. Camera Use in Class

- Students expressed concern that syllabi are written too harshly and strictly, claim it's affecting students that aren't cheating in the attempt to stop the ones that are; also claim the amount of cheating is the same now as it was before the pandemic (around 10%)
- Senators responded that 10% of a class cheating is a lot, and they are putting in a lot of extra time trying to prevent it in order to benefit the students that aren't cheating
- Faculty would like more institutional support to find mutually beneficial solutions across all disciplines
- Some professors are requiring multiple cameras, which are privacy and equity concerns
- Syllabi could be written less harshly and with detailed explanations of how students will be monitored; this may help put students at ease
