- A. Senate President: June McLaughlin
 - New State DEI survey coming soon, will get done in next couple of weeks
 - State Academic Senate points of focus for legislation -
 - Building pathways
 - Increasing faculty diversity
 - Expansion of baccalaureate offerings
 - Strengthening ethnic studies requirement under Title V
 - Saddleback President will require 50% of scheduled classes to be in-person; how would IVC faculty feel about this?
 - Melanie Haeri -
 - * According to VPI Dr. McDonald, the District is committed to safety
 - * Need state of emergency lifted and "color of emergency" to come down
 - * 50% seems arbitrary
- B. Senate Vice President: Jefferey Kaufmann
 - IEC Decision-making manual workgroup
 - Clarify/write down decision making processes
 - Clean up nomenclature
 - Update with current information
 - They are not changing the way decisions are made on campus
 - BDRPC CRSSA funds
 - Funds earmarked for dealing with COVID
 - About half the funds designed to backfill revenue lost during COVID (parking, etc.)
 - We as a college need to discuss the proposals of how to use the funds
 - AB 685 Contact tracing on-campus
 - A company called Traser will run the process
 - Fobs will track which buildings you go into
 - Many privacy questions still remain (how long data is stored, how it's used, who has access, etc.)
 - College Commons
 - A place where faculty could casually congregate to help break up school silos away from students
 - None of the current building projects include providing this kind of area, we as faculty need to push for this if we want it
