6. EXECUTIVE REPORTS

- A. Senate President: June McLaughlin
 - Pressuring college to bring back proctored exams at some point this semester to address concerns about cheating, and to bring back proctoring for DSPS students
 - Asking librarians about thoughts on opening the library in any capacity
 - Student petition from IVC/Saddleback students to stop using Proctorio, citing privacy issues
 - Expanded cabinet concerns
 - Intent was to get more information and it has served that purpose
 - Also talking to cabinet about revising bylaws, to help have our Senate structure look more like Saddleback's (they get a lot more people and compensation)
 - Plan to present new bylaws to extended cabinet and Senate, needs to be voted on by entire college
 - Possible consideration of moving voting for Senate positions to Spring
- B. Senate Vice President: Jefferey Kaufmann
 - IEC won't eliminate some data from program review, but provide qualifiers to explain why it's not representative (small sample size, etc.)
 - Committee grid some committees will have to change because they don't meet often enough to meet contractual obligation, so grid is in a state of flux
 - Voting representation on these committees may be overrepresented by faculty, need to clean that up
- C. Academic Affairs Chair: Robert Melendez
 - InsideIVC Professional Development page has been updated includes description of new processes as well as guides, documents, and videos to help
 - Currently working on questions to present to Academic Affairs that will survey people that complete PD requests asking what they need help with
 - AB1460 CSU Ethnic Studies requirement makes ethnic studies a requirement to graduate from the CSU, and thus community colleges will be required to offer those classes because students will need to have it done before they transfer to a CSU
