 - o (v) Brandee Idelman is replacing Anthony Lin as Senator for the Library
 - Voted to approve -
 - Teacher of the Year Emily Liu! Congratulations!
 - Emily oversees the honors program which has been incredibly successful at IVC. There will be a virtual statewide conference hosted by UCI for <u>Community College Honors Research</u>. Out of the 212 abstracts submitted, 47 (22%) are from IVC students!
 - IVC Honors Night is on Wed, Mar 2
 - Welcome back event for faculty what is your feedback about a luncheon or some in-person gathering? Send Dan your thoughts
 - (v) Deanna Scherger, English, proposed that IVC explore creating a committee to look at General Education and other related <u>topics</u>
 - Discussion some of the related topics are teaching pedagogy and would not be appropriate for a curriculum committee. If a committee was created, it is suggested that it be a subcommittee under Curriculum so that there is only one committee charged with handling curriculum. It was brought up that the link between pedagogy and curriculum is important and not done in any committee right now. Further discussion added that the purview of the Curriculum Committee is the implementation of state regulations concerning curriculum and the subject matter experts and departments have purview of pedagogy.
