- The C.A.F.E. in the Library will be renovated and used for faculty professional development and instructional technology training. Design of space is being planned.
- Faculty Association is reworking student evaluations of faculty. See Melanie

 - Vote approved by consensus
- Mandate discussion:
 - David Bugay discussed concerns faculty have about a mandate to wear a mask while teaching...concerns will be brought to the College Council. Additional concerns were voiced in the opposition, and it was brought up that there may be unvaccinated people in class (HS students won't be required to have a vaccine and some exemptions are likely to be granted).
