4. BRIEF ANNOUNCEMENTS

Emily Liu, Director of the Honors Program – 10th Annual Research Symposium was a success. Of 45 presentations, 42 where from IVC students! (Event Program)

March 12, 2022 – Foundation Awards Dinner...looking for donations.

Chris McDonald, VPI – Spring Enrollments are not looking good.

Applications and enrollments are down dramatically compared to pre-COVID and down still from last spring.

Marketing is doing the typical advertising (TV ads, YouTube, social media, etc.) and is also calling students to remind them to enroll.

4-year enrollments are down as well, and they are taking students lower down on their entry requirements tiers. Those students would likely have been community college students. Enrollments will likely be down ~10% from last spring, yet we have ~7% more classes. Classes will have to be canceled to adjust.

Recommendation: Students are preferring online over on-campus based on enrollments...if you have on-campus classes, consider changing modality.

Dec 10 – lowest enrolled classes will be cancelled.

Students have started receiving information about the process to prove vaccination status.

 - o Critical Race Theory Panel during Flex Week to discuss what it is and isn't
 - Equity Learning Community E3 (Enacting Educational Equity)
 - Cohort, stipend, hands-on training on practical things you can do to review and update curriculum, syllabi, etc. through the equity lens
 - Application will be available soon, program starts in Feb
- Senate Vice President (RJ Dolbin)
 - Program Review Process is usually 5-6 years. IVC has a goal of doing annual updates but have not followed through. There is work to make the annual review much more streamlined (fill out a form). Contact RJ if you want to help create this online form and digital signature process.
 - O IVC Basic Aid Funding Request Typically Davit would brief Senate on this funding request, but the new Decision-Making Manuel allows for dissemination by those in attendance of the committee (BDRPC in this case). If you have any questions or concerns, contact RJ. These are large capital outlay projects, mostly new or renovated buildings.

 - The transfer category/degree requirement section of "Cultural Diversity" will be replaced with only Ethnic Studies courses

7. NEW BUSINESS

- A. <u>Vision Statement</u> submitted to College Council (only feedback so far is the phrase "stands committed")
- B. Technology needs
 - Update on CAFÉ and technology-based pedagogy there will be a walkthrough of the space and a presentation of the changes proposed will be made available at a future meeting before going forward

- IVC will appoint a faculty representative for the search committee for Director of IT at the District (Bob Bramucci's position)
- C. Faculty hiring process discussions
 - CA will end the year with a budget surplus (<u>article one</u>, <u>two</u>). Some of that will come to community colleges. They have agreed to extend the hold-harmless provision of the funding formula until 2025.
 - The faculty hiring process has been looked at by Senate Presidents, College Presidents, and HR. Things under review: Quality of our advertising, clarity of the application and application process, diversity of candidates, and timing of advertising.
