A. SENATE CABINET REPORTS:

- Senate President (Daniel de Roulet)
 - Chancellor's Council Chancellor Burke received 3 different requests for a mandate (IVC & Saddleback Student Associations and FA)
 - o Plans to bring this to the Board for approval to pursue a mandate
 - o Then, input on specifics/requests from both colleges
 - o Expects to bring to the Board in Sep and an approval in Nov
 - Will be effective as of Jan of Spring semester, time is needed for BP/AR updates and contracts with IT and health resources to offer vaccinations
 - o Colleges need time to develop a support and process plan
- Senate Vice President of Equity (Rebecca Beck)
 - o 1st Reading for Equity Group meeting was on 9/17 at 11a (Ch 1-3), join here
- Senate Vice President (RJ Dolbin)
 - o No update other than BPs/ARs in Consent Items
- Academic Affairs Chair (Carolina Kussoy)
 - o Professional Development funds Full-time \$1,800 and part-time \$900
 - o Flex week in Spring will be mostly online with some hybrid seminars
 - Looking into what students see on the schedule concerning open seats vs number of seats available (does this influence enrollment)
- Curriculum Committee Chair (Rick Boone)
 - o Last review to meet the Fall catalog is mid Nov
 - Courses due for 5-year Review here (under Resource Links)

B. GUEST REPORTS:

- Anne Chua (IVC Title IX Investigator/Manager)
 - Faculty are no longer required to officially report sexual harassment brought to their attention. Only Officials with Authority are required. Faculty should encourage reporting but must obtain consent. <u>Title IX at IVC</u>
- Cheryl Bailey (Online Education Committee)

- o Trying to centralize faculty training in Canvas
- o Looking to hire an Online Ed Coord. (or Dir of Center for Innovation) name TBD
- The Distance Ed addendum we added to our curriculum allows us to teach those courses online even after COVID, but we aren't required to
- Technology Master Plan is being revised; Nick (IT Director) is a big proponent of online teaching. If interested in assisting, contact Cheryl cbailey@ivc.edu

- Faculty Association President Elect (Melanie Haeri)
 - Tentative Contract approved by the Board; voting starts 9/20 (via email). If successful, will go to the Board on Sep 27th
- Classified Senate President (Desiree Ortiz)
 - o Concerns with tracing people coming on campus in case of a positive test
 - o Caring Campus inviting faculty to join our efforts
- ASIVC President (DeAngelo Hunter)
 - o No updates (started discussion on mandate during open discussion)

- Board Policies and Administrative Regulations (RJ Dolbin)
 - o <u>AR-5530 Grade grievance</u>
 - Pulled from consent items to be discussed further
 - AR changes VPI made final arborator vs President
 - We believe this should stay with President
 - AR changes Dean added to informal resolution process
 - If Dean agrees with student, Dean can't do anything
 - AR changes Formal process starts with written statement
 - Involves an outside Dean to avoid partiality (insulting?)
 - Saddleback Senate voted that they do not agree with the changes
 - IVC Senate voted that we don't agree with the changes, more discussion
 - o AR 4100 Graduation Requirements
 - BP exists, but no AR, this is a draft AR, no issues/concerns

- Testing requirements and tracking for those who cannot get vaccinated
- Does this include social distancing mandate? Could cause problems in some classrooms
- How would faculty know if a student is cleared to be on campus?
