• Academic Affairs Chair (Carolina Kussoy)

- The faculty hiring process was reviewed last year. The Tier 1 and 2 process is now more clear and easily reproducible. We will focus on Tier 3 transparency this year and need input from all schools.
- Professional Development Funds we will evaluate how much we have and plan
 to adjust the limits for both full and part time instructors. We submitted a
 proposal to the VPI late last year that would allow part-time faculty to use PD
 funds to attend meetings and other campus events. We will evaluate increasing
 the amount of PD funds available to part time faculty (currently %50 of fulltime).

8. OLD BUSINESS

Accreditation and SLOs. Senate and the Faculty Association are gathering information and will pursue compensation (stipend and/or release time) for those who are doing SLO analysis who aren't chairs (SLO analysis is a chair duty). Ask your schools for input.

9. NEW BUSINESS

A. Faculty Hiring

- ECA's short term impact to the FON will penalize districts \$75k for each faculty position under the FON. IVC set to hire 8 (+1 retirement replacement).
- Another goal is a more immediate hiring for retirement replacements
- Saddleback plans to hire ~17 new faculty.

B. Teacher of the Year Process

- Amrik Johal, Assistant Dean of Students, proposes an increase in faculty and student voice to the process and an effort to increase student participation (~200 students vote).
- Amrik is asking schools for inputs, ideas, etc.
- ASIVC representative suggested that the low turnout for recent voting could be related to COVID and that there is not enough marketing for the process.

C. Academic Dishonesty

- First offense students are required to meet with Amrik. Proposal to send a letter for first offense and meeting for second offense.
- Amrik asks that we discuss this with faculty and give feedback
- Issues raised: Concern over the increase in dishonesty since COVID and/or the move to online.

D. Committee Attendance & Guided Pathways

- Senate will review the list of committees to see if we can merge or remove some. There has been a lack of participation in 'critical' committee meeting attendance.
- It was suggested that Senate recommend to the deans that 'critical' committee slots be filled before other service hour requests are granted.
- A tier list could be developed to assist the deans
- Guided Pathway Completion Teams were discussed. It was agreed that they can be used for service hours but not be recognized as a committee.

E. Senate Cabinet Elections

 Senate is seeking advice and recommendations about the split of release time for new cabinet members in the spring semester. This would provide overlap and training for incoming cabinet members.
