 - AR 7123 Recruitment: Full-Time Faculty Review of changes:
 - o Hiring priority list goes to HR and not the board and is reviewed with SC's list
 - Will include at least one DEIA focused questions
 - Staff members can be on hiring committees in extenuating circumstances if they have an appropriate background in the field
 - o EEO rep should, preferably, be outside of the discipline area doing the hiring
 - O Second level interview will include the President, a VP, a Dean, and the Chair.
 - Comment by Jeff Wilson: the contract requires interviews for internal candidates with 7+ semesters...this can be a large number for large departments and might dilute the variety of candidate's being interviewed

 - Faculty Hiring Revised Tier 3 process
 - Met with the VPI and he wants a workgroup to look at all tiers for the hiring process

- Curriculum Committee Chair (Rick Boone)
 - Tiffany Tran, Articulation Officer presented on AB 928
 - Slides
 - Creation of one lower division gen ed pathway CalGETC
 - Reduces Gen Ed to 34 units, reducing units from Humanities and Social and Behavioral Sciences
 - Eliminates Lifelong Learning area
 - Removes world languages, but allows HS AP transfer credits
 - Creation of committee to coordinate state-level transfer degrees
 - All CC students placed on AS Degree for Transfer pathway if pursuing transfer
 - Rick Boone reviewed the curriculum processes from last meeting:
 - Internal Processes We have internal processes covering Senate 10+1 items such as:
 - Course development
 - Certificate development
 - AA/AS award development
 - Cross-listing, interdepartmental listings (Letter of Intent)
 - External Processes We have external processes that affect curriculum:
 - Articulation process for:
 - o Elective credit courses
 - o Course articulation in a GE Area
 - Course to course articulation (1:1)
 - These are initiated by IVC, but decisions are made by the UCs, CSUs, Privates

No Set Processes:

- Determining what class can request articulation
- Removing a class from articulation in a GE Area
- Contesting another department's class in a GE Area
- Removing or contesting a class in our own AA/AS GE list
- Discussion
 - How do we handle one department asking articulation for a class that is not their primary field (e.g., Psychology approved as a Math/Stats class)
 - It was asked that a GE Committee be created to address these process issues. Rick mentioned that this can be discussed at the Curriculum Committee and that another committee would dilute participation even further.
