 - The District was awarded a \$300k grant for our BLOOM program
 - Faculty Hiring a sample run of the algorithm based on today's numbers was shown.
 - The first few positions are: Library, Theater Arts, LLR, ESL...
 - This is without school/dept declining, AB 928 discussions, FON impact, etc.
 - AB 928 might impact some departments
 - The district took a one-time payout that included an increase in the FON. We hired several fulltime positions to get this money, and this might impact future hiring levels
 - HR has proposed language for job announcements, please bring back to your schools for comments.
