 - 2024-2025 encumbrances
 - o As of April 8, the embarances are: FT professional development is \$89,875, for PT professional development it is \$29,805, and for PT stipend it is \$29,874 (\$149,540 total).
 - Proposal to increase individual PD allotment for FT and PT faculty
 - Starting July 1, the professional development for FT faculty will increase to \$2,500 a year, and for PT faculty it will be \$1250.
