REFUND POLICY

Full refunds are issued for classes canceled by IVC. If you are unable to attend a class, notify the Extended Education Office three days before the class begins. AN INTRODUCTION TO VOICEOVERS (GETTING STARTED IN VOICE ACTING)

“Wow, you have a great voice!” Have you heard that more times than you can count? Or maybe you listen to your favorite audiobooks, commercials, or cartoon characters and think, “I could do that!” If so, then you could have what it takes to begin working as a professional Voiceover Artist. Explore the voiceover industry with your instructor, a professional, working voice actor from the voice acting training company Voices For All, in a one-on-one, personalized, video chat setting. Discover current trends in the industry and how they make it easy and affordable for just about anyone to get involved. In this one-time, 90-minute, introductory class, you'll also learn about the different types of voiceovers and the tools you'll need to find success. And then... we're rolling! Your instructor will record you as you read a real script, then offer some coaching so you can improve your delivery.

Your instructor will take notes on your performance so you can receive a professional voiceover evaluation later. After the class, you will have the knowledge necessary to help you decide if this is something you'd like to pursue. You owe it to yourself to finally explore the possibilities of this fun and rewarding field! ABOUT EMERITUS CLASSES

The Irvine Valley College Emeritus Institute program affirms the importance of intellectual activity, critical thinking, and creative expressions for older adults.

EMERITUS REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The registration process occurs three times per year in the fall, spring, and summer semesters.

- **NEW STUDENTS** (those who have never taken a class at IVC or Saddleback), will need to fill out an application to receive a student profile and login information.
- **RETURNING STUDENTS** (those who skipped a fall or spring semester), will need to complete an application to reactivate their student profile before being able to register.

To access the new registration system, follow these steps:

 - a. Click on **Portal for Students, Faculty & Staff** (upper right side)
2. Sign in using your college email address and password
3. From the applications portal, click the **MySite image**
4. Select Fall 2025
 - a. This will open the new home page for MySite/Banner
 - i. Select **Open Registration Dashboard** under the **Registration Self-Service tile**
 1. This opens to the **Student/Registration** page

WHAT WOULD YOU LIKE TO DO?

- **Registration Appointment:** This will show students their registration date, which is now called "time tickets."
- **Registration Status:** Look for this message: Time Tickets do not allow registration at this time. Please register within these times: 06/09/2025 8:00am-12/17/2025 11:59pm
- Registration is **date specific**. Students cannot register prior to their assigned time ticket (formerly known as "registration appointment").

Students are not permitted to attend classes in which they are not officially enrolled.

If the class you wish to enroll in is full, please add your name to the waitlist. If and when a space becomes available, you will be notified by text and email. You will receive an authorization code (formerly known as "APC") and have 24 hours to add the class.

Faculty reserve the right to drop students who do not attend the first class session.

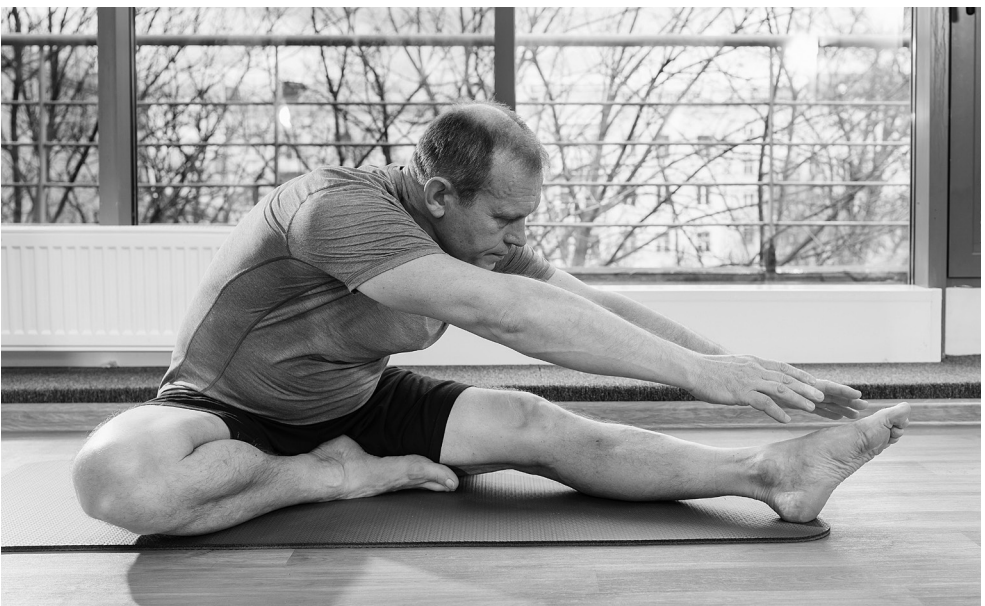

LINE DANCE LEVELS



What class should I register for?

Absolute Beginner (AB)— This classification refers to a line dance routine that is choreographed to suit those who have had absolutely no previous dance experience.

Beginner (BEG)— This classification is referring to a line dance routine that will build upon the skills learned at the Absolute Beginner level. Routines will be suitable for those who have some previous dance experience.

- **Beginner/Improver**— Previous dance experience and basic line dance skills geared toward line dancers who have some experience as well as knowledge of steps and terminology. Most students at this level have spent at least a year in a Beginner class or have equivalent experience.
- **High Beginner/Improver**— Previous dance experience at beginner level and a good knowledge of basics. More complex patterns and steps will be included in dances at this level.

Improver (IMP)— This classification is referring to choreography that will assume some previous dance experience and basic skills. Improver level dances will introduce additional step patterns and routines up to 64 counts.

- **Improver/Easy Intermediate** — Students who have previous dance experience and are comfortable with beginner and improver steps and terminology. This is a transitional level that expands to more challenging choreography.
- **Improver/Intermediate** — Students that have mastered the improver level and are ready to learn more difficult routines, step combinations, body movement, timing and styling.
- **Easy Intermediate/Intermediate**— This classification is referring to a level of difficulty that builds upon basic steps and introduces more complete patterns, turns and directional changes.

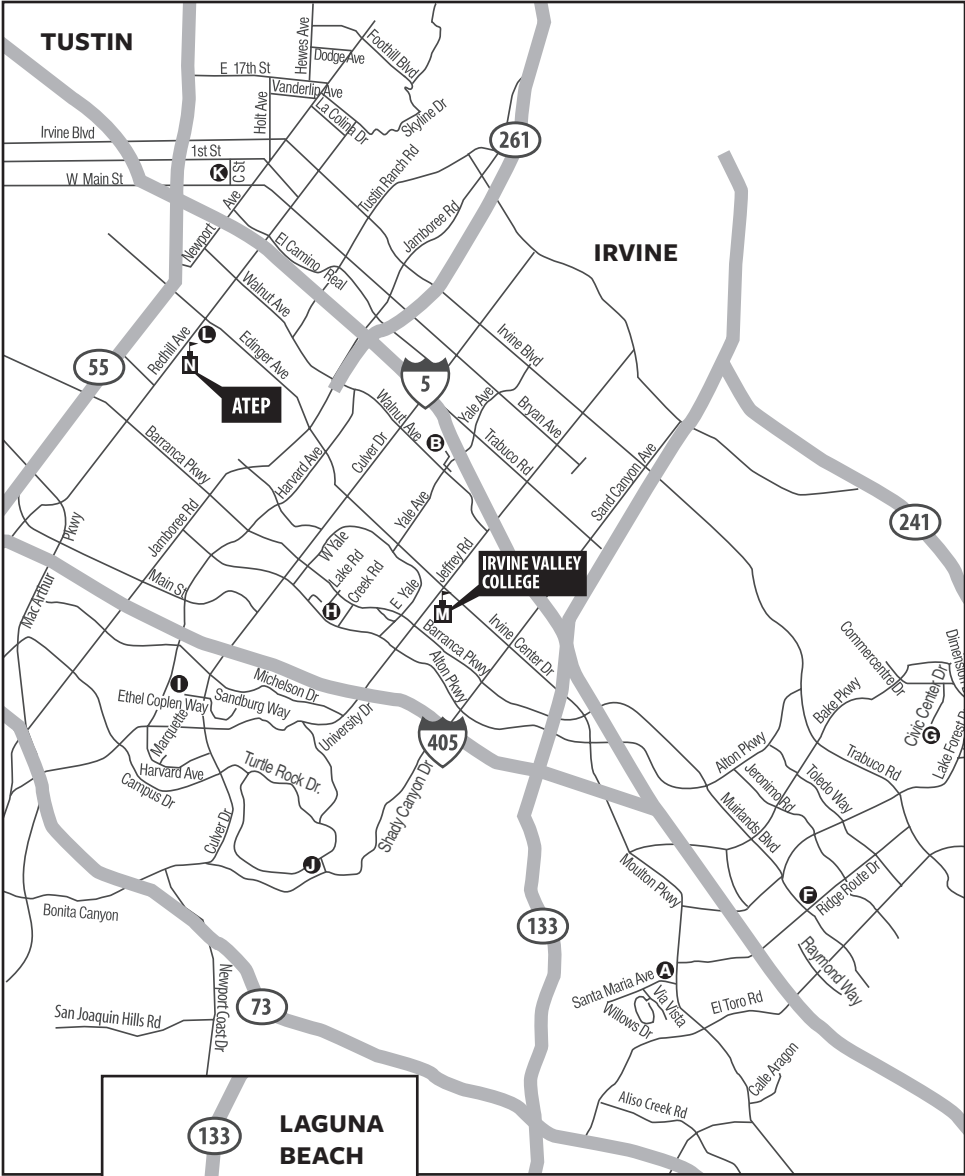
Intermediate (INT)— This classification will feature dance routines suitable for experienced dancers. Those who have mastered a comprehensive range of step patterns and movements. An Intermediate routine is likely to feature interesting step combinations, pauses, syncopations, body movements, timing variations and styling.

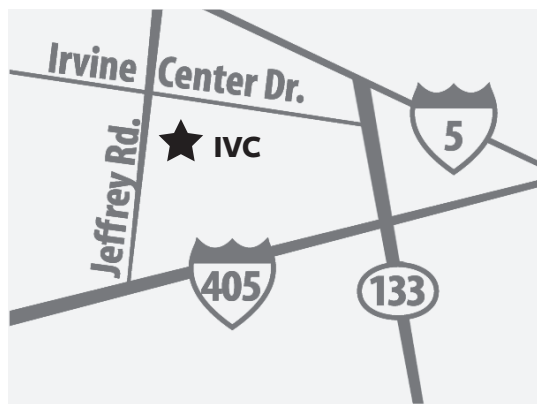
