## **FINANCE REPORT**

Karen Moran provided an update on the financials with the following talking points:

- The SOCCCD switched to a new system called Banner on July 1 which will impact financial reporting.
- The finance committee set goals for this year.
- We will provide whatever support we can as the Banner reports are created.

Upon motion duly made by Kathy Schmeilder and seconded by Mike Drennen, the Board of Governors unanimously approved the following proposal:

## **BOARD DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE**

The board matrix is complete, and the committee is working on prospective as well as new board member packets. Additionally, the committee would like to recruit new members to join the board development committee.

## **2024-2025 RECAP AND PREVIEWS OF 2025-2026**

This past fiscal year was a record setter which included the following highlights:

- We completed a successful RFP for new investment advisor.
- It was a record setting year including contributions for Giving Day and Celebrating Excellence
- The endowment balance reached a new level and exceeded \$3 million for the first time.
- The Foundation's total assets went over \$5 million.
- \$1.182 million in total contributions, which is an 18% increase over last year.

In addition, the following are new opportunities underway:

- We are in the final stages of securing a Gift to name a classroom in the Liberal Arts building.
- We're expecting a bequest of \$100,000 for the computer science program.
- Through the Samueli grant, we are receiving \$50,000 for MESA scholarships and \$40,000 for matching funds for STEM related gifts.

## **PRESIDENT'S UPDATE**

- Fall enrollment exceeded over 16,000.
- Student Services building underway and the topping ceremony is tomorrow.
- Arts promenade is underway.
- Additional \$100,000 from the City of Irvine for scholarships
- Partnership with City of Irvine to help housing insecure students.
- \$3 million gift from the Samueli Foundation to strengthen pathways for community college students pursuing degrees and careers in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM).
