Fire Procedures

Fire Prevention

- Keep exits and hallways clear and free of potential obstructions, such as boxes, desks, and bicycles.
- Do not overload outlets plug one appliance into an outlet at a time.
- Avoid using extension cords whenever possible.
- Smoking is prohibited in all University buildings, including residences.
- Unplug coffee pots and hot plates before leaving the office for the day.

In the Event of a Fire

- If you smell smoke or detect a fire, activate the nearest alarm and call 911 or 5234 from a campus phone.
- Before opening any door, use the back of your hand to see if it is hot if it is hot, leave it closed and stuff towels or clothes in the cracks and open a window.
- If the door is not hot, open it slowly (CAUTION: the doorknob may be hot) and be prepared to close it quickly if necessary.
- Stay low when moving through smoke and walk to the nearest exit.
- Exit the building quickly but cautiously.
- If you see or smell smoke in a hall or stairways, use another exit. Do not use elevators.
- Go directly to your building's Emergency Assembly Point.
