

This unique, joint program guarantees a Bachelor's Degree in 4 years from Cal State Fullerton and a Master's degree in 1 more year.

- Choose from three Master's degrees
- Only 30 students are admitted each year taking classes as a group with saved seats in classes
- Students study 2 years at IVC plus 2 years at CSUF-Irvine for a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration in 4 years
- Applicants must place into IVC Math 11 and Writing 1
- Class of 2017: Application deadline is April 28, 2017
- Class of 2018: Early admittance applications due by May 19, 2017

Why?

- Priority consideration for admission at UCI and UCLA
- Priority registration for classes
- Smaller class size and enriched coursework
- Recognition on transcript and at graduation
- Designated counselor and scholarships
- Access to research opportunities

How?

- Application
- High school transcript with a3.25 non-weighted GPA or higher
- Writing 1 eligibility or appropriate ACT or SAT score
- Essay
- Letter of recommendation



Transfer Alliance Program (TAP)



Priority consideration for admission to majors in the College of Letters and Science

- ❖ Fall 2016
 - 79% of IVC TAP students were admitted to UCLA
 - 21% of IVC non-TAP students were admitted to UCLA
- **See 3.** Be admitted to Honors Program
- Take 5 Honors classes
- Maintain at least a 3.25 GPA



Honors to Honors

Priority consideration for admission to UCI and the Campus wide Honors Program

- ❖ Fall 2016
 - 89.4% of H2H students were admitted to UCI
 - 55.5% of non-H2H students were admitted to UCI
- Be admitted to the Honors Program
- Take 5 Honors classes
- Maintain at least a 3.7 GPA

Can also do TAG (Transfer Admission Guarantee) for most majors


