WHAT ARE TAGS?

TAGS are agreements/contracts with universities:

- Admissions
 - Guaranteed admissions (if follow through with all requirements)
 - > Priority admissions / early admissions
- Pathway
- Target to shoot for, especially GPA
- Back pocket / lessens anxiety



TYPES OF TAGS

- •ADT (aka AA-T/AS-T)
- UC TAGS
- Private University TAGS
- Out of State TAGS



ADT (AA-T/AS-T)

- Degrees offered at California Community Colleges.
- Guaranteed <u>admission to a CSU, but not necessarily to a particular campus or major.</u>
- Priority consideration for admissions
- 60 semester units after transfer to obtain a BA/BS degree
- GPA bump of .1 for impacted majors

- 1) Apply for your CSU-GE or IGETC Certification on MySite (Jan. 30th deadline)
- 2) Apply for your AA-T/AS-T on MySite (Jan. 30th)
- 3) IVC will e-verify for you by deadline

Some campuses offer an early review of your academic record, early admission notification, and guidance on major preparation and GE courses.

Note: You can TAG only one UC!

UC Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) for Students Applying for 2017-2018 Admission

Six University of California (UC) campuses offer guaranteed admission to students from all California community colleges (CCC). Interested students must meet campus-specific requirements to qualify for a UC TAG. By participating in a TAG program, students can ensure their admission to a specific UC campus, some of which offer an early review of a students' academic record, early admission notification (no later than November 15, 2016 for a fall 2017 TAG applications), and specific guidance on major preparation and general education coursework.

Who can file a TAG?

Only students transferring directly from a California community college (CCC) are considered for a TAG, including international students (those with a visa). A CCC transfer student is one who has completed at least 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units at one or more California community colleges, and the last college the student attended in a regular session (fall/spring or fall/winter/spring) before admission to a UC campus is a California community college. All UC campuses that offer TAGs require students to meet this definition.

Students who have already earned a bachelor's degree, graduate degree, and/or professional degree cannot receive at TAG. Students who have previously enrolled at a UC campus during a regular term (not including summer session) cannot submit a TAG application to return to that campus. Students concurrently enrolled in high school are not eligible for TAG.

To pursue a TAG, students must:

- Complete the online UC TAG application and submit it during the appropriate filing period September 1-30, 2016 for fall 2017 admission at uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu.
- Once a TAG is submitted, fulfill all remaining coursework and GPA requirements designated on the TAG agreement.
- Apply for admission to UC during the appropriate filing period at <u>universityofcalifornia.edu/apply</u>.

Students are strongly encouraged to consult with their community college counselor prior to completing/submitting the TAG application. Additionally, transfer students do not have to participate in TAG to be considered for admission. Non-TAG students must also apply for UC admission during the appropriate application filing period at university of california.edu/apply.



- Most students will TAG with one of these four UC campuses.
- UC Irvine is the most popular.

 You may only request to TAG to <u>ONE</u> UC Campus.

So, we suggest that you think critically about your choices!

WHEN TO APPLY FOR UCTAG?

- All 6 of the UC campuses that offer TAG allow you to TAG for the fall admission cycle.
- " However, only Merced allows TAG for mid-year transfers (Spring Semester).



NOTE: Applying for TAG is NOT applying for admissions!

You must ALSO apply for general transfer admissions in November!

Priority consideration for admission to majors in the College of Letters and Science

Fall 2016

79% of IVCTAP students were admitted to UCLA

21% of IVC non-TAP students were admitted to UCLA

Be admitted to Honors Program

Take 5 Honors classes

Maintain at least a 3.25 GPA



Honors to Honors

Priority consideration for admission to UCI and the Campus wide Honors Program

- ❖ Fall 2016
 - 89.4% of H2H students were admitted to UCI
 - 55.5% of non-H2H students were admitted to UCI
- ❖ Be admitted to the Honors Program
- Take 5 Honors classes
- Maintain at least a 3.7 GPA

Can also do TAG (Transfer Admission Guarantee) for most majors
